Outcomes: This educational visit was a great success, leaving students with valuable knowledge and insights into real-world applications of sewage treatment.






AN EXTENSION ACTIVITY ON FAMININE HYGIENE ACTIVITY (17TH MARCH 2025)

PATENT PUBLISHED ON AUTOMATED DISCIPLINE DUTY ALLOCATION SYSTEM USING EXCEL AND PYTHON

(28TH FEBRUARY 2025)

Discipline Committee of RTCCS published patent titled " Automated Discipline Duty Allocation System Using Excel and Python " has been officially published. The patent was filed on February 11, 2025, and published on February 28, 2025. The present invention relates to an automated discipline duty allocation system that efficiently assigns supervision duties to teachers in educational institutions. The system utilizes a Python-based algorithm and an Excel-based scheduling input to ensure fair workload distribution. The system dynamically updates duty counts and prioritizes teachers with fewer assignments. A structured weekly duty chart is generated, and historical records are maintained, streamlining administrative processes in educational institutions. This system reduces manual effort, eliminates scheduling conflicts, and ensures transparency in workload management.
